Here are the answers to some FAQ to help us see each other again. The changes we have made are to fit with the regulations put in place by the government and Archbishop.

What will Wildfire look like?

- Wildfire will run on Friday nights from 7:00-9pm SHARP starting 31st July (2nd week back of school)
- You won't need to socially distance from other youth, but you will need to maintain the 1.5m rule from your leaders.
- Mostly things will be exactly the same as they usually were.
- As you enter, you will need to use hand sanitiser, get your name marked off, pay & have your water bottle placed in the designated area.

Where will it be held?

- Wildfire will be moved to the main hall and you will NOT be able to access other areas of the site aside from the bathrooms (we will no longer be using the small hall).

What will I need to bring?

- \$3 to cover supper (which will all be individually wrapped foods) as usual
- Your own drink bottle
- Your own bible if you'd prefer that rather than a sheet of paper

How will everyone be kept COVID-19 safe?

- Spaces will be appropriately cleaned prior to the meeting & after the meeting. (We have specific cleaning instructions that will be followed)
- You will need to maintain physical distancing from leaders
- Hand sanitiser will need to be used upon entering & leaving the main hall.
- A full record of attendees will be kept to ensure effective contact tracing if transmission occurs.

- Youth and leaders who experience ANY symptoms of COVID-19 should NOT attend.
- If numbers increase significantly, we will introduce pre-registering to ensure our numbers are kept to what the space can hold.
- Bathrooms will be stocked with soap & paper towels.
- No bibles will be issued, you will receive a sheet of paper with the passage on it.

Do I need to Pre-register?

For the time being, you will not need to as we are not close to hitting our max amount of people allowed in the hall.

Will youth still be online too?

No, given the feedback from parents we have decided from term 3 we will only be doing youth group face-to face.

What do drop-off and pick-up look like?

- Parents of NEW youth/guests are welcome to bring their child to the welcome desk
- We request that parents of REGULAR youth remain in their vehicle during pick-up and drop-off, as parents who exit their cars contribute to the total participants on site. This impacts our COVID-19 safety protocols and obedience to government regulations.

If parents can please arrive 9pm SHARP for pick-up, this will love the youth team & those who will need to spend time cleaning after.

What happens if there is another wave of COVID-19?

We are committed to follow any government advice to ensure our youth and leaders are safe. If medical or government advice is given that gatherings should stop, Wildfire will return to its pure ONLINE mode immediately. All previous attendees will be notified by email.

What if I'm a bit sick, can I come to Wildfire?

- If you are experience any symptoms associated with COVID-19, please DO NOT attend Wildfire.
- If you experience any symptoms in the following days or weeks, please arrange a COVID-19 test as soon as possible– if you test positive, it is best to find out quickly so that potential contacts can be notified.

What can I do to help?

- Please follow the rules above carefully to ensure the safety of all, to love one another & so that we can continue meeting face-to-face!
- If you or a parent would be willing to be on a cleaning roster please let Kat know, this would be a huge help. We will probably need 2 people each week.
